There are an endless number of state parks and hiking trails throughout Maryland. In addition to open spaces, many parks offer camping facilities, picnic spots, playgrounds, and boat launch areas or rental services for water equipment. Below is a list of favorites from locals and military members who have lived here for a while.

° Gunpowder Falls State Park covers 18,000 acres northeast of Baltimore City. This state park has six main areas that provide playgrounds, a swimming area, picnic areas, hiking and biking trails, fishing areas, a boat launch site, and kayaking rentals. 

- North Point State Park is a short distance to the southeast of Baltimore City and boasts a lot of historical views and trails. Dogs are warmly welcomed here along with picnickers. 8400 North Point Rd, Edgemere, MD 21219
- Patuxent Research Refuge, directly southwest of Ft. Meade, is a wildlife refuge with hiking trails around a lake. 230 Bald Eagle Dr, Laurel, MD

Perhaps strolling through large parks isn't enjoyable for you. If you enjoy admiring architecture and other forms of stunning scenery, have a look at this compilation.






### Summer Bucket List cont.

As you can see, Maryland has a lot to offer this summer. Get out there and explore!











