

FORT MEADE SPOUSES' CLUB SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND APPLICATION
2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR



The Fort Meade Spouses' Club (FMSC) Scholarship Award is awarded annually to graduating High School Seniors and Continuing Education Students. This award is for students who rise to the challenges of Academia and still find time to volunteer in their community.

This scholarship will be applied to the 2023-2024 academic school year. This is a competitive scholarship; all eligible students are encouraged to apply and to take care to submit the best package they can to accurately reflect who they are. Multiple recipients may be selected.

Applicants will be notified at the end of March of their application status.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ❖ The applicant must be a dependent child (unmarried) of any military member from any branch, active duty, retired, deceased military personnel, Reservist or National Guard, not to exceed 23 years of age.
- ❖ Additionally, applicants must meet **one** of the following criteria:
 1. To qualify as a full-time student, a minimum of 12 credits each semester for the academic year of the scholarship is required.
 2. All other applicants will qualify as a part time student.
- ❖ Military member must reside in the Fort Meade Area. Applicants must verify military dependency status.
- ❖ See page 2 for criteria that applies specifically to high school students only and continuing education students only.
- ❖ Submit a completed application on time as per details below.
- ❖ Volunteer in the community.

Financial Restrictions:

- ❖ Additional financial restrictions and obligations:
 1. Scholarships will be payable directly to the school for tuition only. Scholarships will be paid when the FMSC receives a detailed tuition statement of all financial activity on the student's account, to include hours enrolled, tuition and general institution fees, and any scholarships or grants.
 2. Winners have until **August 1, 2024** to submit a tuition statement from their school. Unclaimed funds will be retained by the FMSC.
 3. Failure to submit documentation on time will result in forfeiture of scholarship.
 4. Tuition will be paid directly to the school after the Scholarship Director has verified that all financial restrictions and regulations have been met.
 5. If a scholarship winner receives 80% tuition money from other scholarships, tuition assistance, GI Bill, Post 9-11 GI Bill transfer, or any other sources that do not require repayment, the scholarship winner will become ineligible for the scholarship.
 6. Scholarships may be used at any accredited college, university, business, or vocational school for one year not to exceed the amount awarded.

Required Documents to be Submitted with Application:

- Please answer the following prompt below with a minimum 1 page response.

There are 24 hours in a day. If, after all of your volunteering and daily to do's were completed, how would you spend your last 9 hours?

- Proof of Military Status
 - DD214, DEERS enrollment, copy of orders, letter from Command or other documentation.
- Two proofs of **sponsor** residency in the Fort Meade area:
 - One copy of a rental, mortgage, lease agreement, housing contract or property tax. One copy of the top portion of a cable, landline or home utility bill, bank statement, or credit card bill (with account numbers blacked out.) Cell phone bills are not acceptable as proof of residency.
- A recent letter of recommendation from a non-family member. The letter is required to be from a supervisor where you have volunteered on an ongoing basis. The letter must include your responsibilities, and how long you have been a volunteer with them.
 - Please be sure that the letter includes the contact information of your reference for verification purposes. Letters must be received by the deadline for scholarship applications. (Note: letters of recommendation cannot be accepted from members of the FMSC Scholarship Committee or other applicants for this scholarship.)

High School Students:

- Submit **official transcripts** for your junior year and first semester of your senior year.
 - Home school students: transcript submitted by the parent/guardian of the homeschooler
 - Transcripts may be sent to scholarships@fortmeadespousesclub.org. Must include transcript request in packet that is postmarked by March 17, 2023.

Continuing Education Students:

- Submit **official transcripts** for your previous year of study (may be senior year of high school) and first semester of this year's studies.
 - Transcripts may be sent to scholarships@fortmeadespousesclub.org. Must include transcript request in packet that is postmarked by March 17, 2023.
