FORT MEADE SPOUSES' CLUB SPOUSES SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND APPLICATION
2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR



The Fort Meade Spouses' Club (FMSC) Spouses Scholarship is awarded annually to spouses of enlisted service members in the Fort Meade area. This award is for military spouses committed to volunteerism and academic achievement.

This scholarship will be applied to the **2026-2027** academic school year. Multiple recipients will be selected for this competitive scholarship and all eligible applicants are encouraged to apply.

Applicants will be notified in April of their application status.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ❖ The applicant must be the spouse of any military member from any branch, active duty, retired, deceased military personnel, Reservist or National Guard who resides in the Fort Meade Area.
- ❖ Additionally, applicants must meet **one** of the following criteria:
 - a. To qualify as a full-time student, a minimum of 12 credits each semester for the academic year of the scholarship is required. **OR**
 - b. All other applicants will qualify as a part time student.
- ❖ Applicants must live on Fort Meade or in the surrounding Fort Meade area.
- ❖ Be an active volunteer in the military community.

Financial Restrictions:

Additional Financial Restrictions and Obligations:

1. Scholarships will be payable directly to the school for tuition only and will be paid when the FMSC receives a detailed statement of all financial activity on the student's account, to include hours enrolled, tuition and general institution fees, and any scholarships or grants.
2. Winners have until **August 1, 2027** to submit a bill from their school. Unclaimed funds will be retained by the FMSC.
3. Failure to submit documentation on time will result in forfeiture of scholarship.
4. Tuition will be paid directly to the school after the Scholarship Director has verified that all financial restrictions and regulations have been met.
5. If the scholarship winner receives 100% tuition money from other scholarships, tuition assistance, GI Bill, Post 9-11 GI Bill transfer, or any other sources that do not require repayment, the scholarship winner will become ineligible for the scholarship.
6. Scholarships may be used at any accredited college, university, business or vocational school for one year not to exceed the amount awarded

Required Documents to be Submitted with Application:

- Respond to the following prompt with a minimum 1 ½ page response:
 - Why do you believe volunteering and community service are essential, particularly in military families? How have you personally contributed to this tradition?
 - How have you inspired others to volunteer or contribute to their community through your actions or leadership?
- Proof of Military Status
 - Examples are: Copies of DD214, DEERS Enrollment, or Letter from Command.
 - If you have further questions, please contact scholarships@fortmeadespousesclub.org
- Two proofs of **sponsor** residency in the Fort Meade area:
 - One copy of a rental, mortgage, lease agreement, housing contract or property tax.
 - One copy of the top portion of a cable, landline or home utility bill, bank statement or credit card bill (with account numbers blacked out). Cell phone bills are not acceptable as proof of residency.
- If available, **transcripts** should be submitted from your appropriate higher level of education.
 - Transcripts may be sent to scholarships@fortmeadespousesclub.org from school officials. The official request for transcripts must be included in the packet postmarked by March 20, 2026.
 - Associates, business, and vocational school students: submit official high school transcripts if completed in the last 2 years
 - Bachelors students: submit official transcripts from associates degree if applicable or high school only if completed within the last 2 years
 - Masters students: submit official transcripts from your undergraduate program
 - Ph.D. students: submit official transcripts from your master's program if applicable, or prior course of study
 - Official transcripts for any courses taken in the previous 2 years
- Two current letters of recommendation from non-family members. For verification purposes, one letter is required to be from your supervisor from recent volunteer experience or from someone with whom you volunteered. Please be sure that the letter includes contact information for your references. Letters must be received by the deadline for scholarship applications. (Note: letters of recommendation cannot be accepted from members of the FMSC Scholarship Committee or other applicants for this scholarship.)
